- Violins II:** Rests in measures 1-3, then a melodic line starting in measure 4 with *ppp* dynamic.
- Violas:** Rests throughout.
- Violoncellos:** Rests throughout.
- Contrabasses:** Active in measures 1-3 with *pp* dynamic and accents, then rests in measures 4-8.
